

Internet Treasure Hunt

Rules and Procedures

- 1 Woodbridge Methodist Church (WMC) is organising and running this Treasure Hunt for the fun and enrichment of all those who enjoy Woodbridge.
- 2 It is our intention that this should be a fun and entertaining event and that all the rules and procedures are clearly stated to ensure that everyone has a fair chance to win the prize.
- 3 Everyone is welcome to participate by completing the on line form available via the WMC website.
- 4 Only valid and completed entry forms will be accepted ie where the sender has provided a valid e-mail address and an answer for each question.
- 5 Each valid entry will be acknowledged by a return e-mail containing the assigned and unique ID Number for that entry together with the nominated date and time when the prize will be presented.
- 6 By submitting a form the sender agrees to abide by all rules and procedures described in this document plus those related to the use of the prizes which are provided elsewhere.
- 7 WMC intends to run treasure hunts on a monthly basis.
- 8 Everybody with an e-mail address and access to the internet can submit one entry for each Treasure Hunt.
- 9 Only the first completed entry form from the sender's e-mail address will be accepted.
- 10 When setting each Treasure Hunt WMC has strived to ensure there is only one correct answer for each question. In this matter the WMC decision regarding the correct answer is final and all participants agree to abide by this decision. No correspondence will be offered even when participants believe their answers are better.
- 11 The correct answers will be given at WMC on the nominated Saturday at our coffee morning
- 12 If two or more fully correct entries are received then these IDs are put in a hat and prizes awarded by random selection of the id from 'the hat'.
- 13 The ID for each person attending the WMC coffee will be noted before the presentation.
- 14 Only one ID can be accepted for each person attending the WMC coffee morning.
- 15 Participants will be asked to confirm both their ID number and their e-mail address before any prizes are awarded.
- 16 Winners are awarded the appropriate 'winning certificate' which is a valuable and unique document that should be kept safely. Winners will not copy or reproduce their certificate.
- 17 Ownership of winning certificates passes to the winner at the nominated coffee morning and responsibility for its safety passes to the winners from that time onward.
- 18 WMC cannot, under any circumstances, re-produce any of the Winning Certificates.
- 19 The winner must use the awarded prize and may not sell or pass the winning certificate to any other party.
- 20 The winner may be required to pass the Winning Certificate to the nominated establishment when claiming their prize.
- 21 WMC will provide a copy of these rules and procedures via its website and it retains the right to change, improve or alter these rules as and when it deems necessary from time to time
- 22 WMC is not responsible for any technical failures that impede or prevent service operation.
- 23 WMC confirms that all personal data in the Treasure Hunt will be held safely and fully compliant with current privacy laws and this data will not be passed to any other organisation.
- 24 By accepting these rules all participants provide their permission for WMC to retain e-mail addresses for the distribution of information associated with the Treasure Hunt.
